ECEEF 2010 to Focus on Growth Strategies

WASHINGTON, DC, November 23, 2009—Strategies for driving growth despite economic uncertainty will be the focus of the next Exhibition and Convention Executives Forum (ECEEF), Wednesday, June 2, 2010, in the J. W. Marriott, Washington, DC.

ECEEF producer Sam Lippman announced the following speakers and sessions:

- Keynote speaker Peter Weedfald, President and Chief Marketing Officer of General Displays and Technologies, will reveal how his company relies on exhibitions to improve customer care and protect its competitive lead.
